ROTARY SUPPORTS THESE PROJECTS WORLDWIDE

POLIO

In Australia everybody is immunised against the debilitating effects from contracting Polio. In 1985 Rotary International took on the challenge of eradicating Polio by the year 2005 by vaccinating every child with oral vaccine.

To date there are only 5 countries left in the world with small pockets of Polio outbreaks and we are very optimistic that the project will see a Polio free world.

ROTARY AGAINST MALARIA

This project is funded by a large Rotary Foundation grant. It aims to eradicate Malaria from the SW Pacific Islands. This is being achieved by the provision of impregnated bed nets, the building and staffing of Malaria testing centres, and research funding.

EDUCATED SMILES

This sponsorship project gives children a better start in life in a remote Bali village. By sponsoring a child we help them with an education and to ensure their family can find a better future.
